

**Wulf Utian Council of Affiliated Menopause Societies (CAMS) Award  
for Achievement in Furthering Women's Health**

**Introduction**

This award was established in recognition of Wulf Utian, who led the establishment of CAMS, and is open to any member who has supported their local society and/or has demonstrated exceptional work in their own country to further education on menopause. Nominations can come from CAMS member societies or via self-nomination. The recipient receives free registration to the World Congress and is presented with a plaque at the World Congress. The recipient's local society is requested to support travel and accommodation costs.

**Process**

1. Criteria

- a. Evidence of achievements must be provided;
- b. Achievements must be relevant to women's mid-life health;
- c. Achievements must have taken place in the last 10 years; and
- d. The achievements need to be related in some way to CAMS.

2. Selection

- a. The Selection Committee is comprised of CAMS Officers plus an IMS Past President
- b. Selection Criteria
  - i. Quality of Achievement;
  - ii. Relevance to CAMS activities e.g. World Menopause Day, translations etc.;
  - iii. Impact / Outcome / Legacy; and
  - iv. Level of personal involvement (if a joint venture).
